School families are required to perform a total of ten (10) volunteer hours by the end of the school year or pay a \$250 exemption fee. At the time of school registration, families must choose to either donate the ten (10) volunteer hours or pay the exemption fee.

<u>CHROMEBOOKS</u> – Starting in the 2017-2018 school year St. Paul's Lutheran School will be implementing a 1 to 1 Chromebook program in grades 5-8. In preparation for that big step, this year's 8th grade is going to be helping us run a pilot program on the Chromebooks. This is another step towards equipping our students with the skills needed to be successful in the 21st century.

ONLINE ENROLLMENT - We will be using a service called Smart Tuition for tuition payments this year. To ease the transition to this system, we will be pulling information out of Sycamore to provide to Smart Tuition. Smart Tuition will then send you an email asking you to confirm your contact information, enter your payment information, select a payment plan, and pay the registration fee. We will be pulling information out of Sycamore on March 23rd. Anyone who has not enrolled through Sycamore by that day will have to enter their own information in Smart Tuition. The process is not long or complicated, but we want to make it as simple as possible by pulling the information out of Sycamore for you.
