The following is offered as a daily discipline for your reading, study, prayer, and praise.

I. Begin with: In the Name of the Father and of the + Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

II. Confess Baptism, Part 4, What does such baptizing with water signify?--*Answer.* It signifies that the old Adam in us should, by daily contrition and repentance, be drowned and die with all sins and evil lusts, and, again, a new man daily come forth and arise; who shall live before God in righteousness and purity forever.

Where is this written?--Answer. St. Paul says Romans, chapter 6: We are buried with Christ by Baptism into death, that, like as He was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.

III. PRAYER OF THE WEEK:

Lord Jesus, help me grow in faith and goodness, not for the sake of earning my eternal salvation, which You have settled for me through Your death and resurrection, but out of love for You and the Heavenly Father. Thank You for the privilege of believing in You. Inspire me that my faith in You would be no secret to those who live around me. Let my light shine, that people may see You living in me and so glorify You and my Heavenly Father. In Your Name I pray. Amen.

V. DAILY PRAYERS (Please try to focus your prayers on the theme of each day):
