The following is offered as a daily discipline for your reading, study, prayer, and praise.

- I. Begin with: In the Name of the Father and of the + Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.
- II. The Sacrament of the Altar As the head of the family should teach it in a simple way to his household. What is the Sacrament of the Altar? It is the true body and blood of our Lord Jesus Christ, under the bread and wine, for us Christians to eat and to drink, instituted by Christ Himself. Where is this written? The holy Evangelists, Matthew, Mark, Luke, and St. Paul, write thus: Our Lord Jesus Christ, the same night in which He was betrayed, took bread: and when He had given thanks, He brake it, and gave it to His disciples, and said, Take, eat; this is My body, which is given for you. This do in remembrance of Me. After the same manner also He took the cup, when He had supped, gave thanks, and gave it to them, saying, Take, drink ye all of it. This cup is the new testament in My blood, which is shed for you for the remission of sins. This do ye, as oft as ye drink it, in remembrance of Me.

## III. PRAYER OF THE WEEK:

Lord Jesus Christ, it is You, isn't it, coming to me in the Lord's Supper? It is You in the flesh, with the ordinary bread and Your body broken on the Cross, filling me with Your presence, Your love, Your forgiveness, and filling me with the memory of everything You have done for me by Your death and resurrection. You are really there for me. Thank You Lord Jesus. Amen.
