The following is offered as a daily discipline for your reading, study, prayer, and praise.

I. Begin with: *In the Name of the Father and of the + Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.*

II. . Confess the Introduction to the Lord's Prayer: *Hallowed be Thy name. What does this mean?*--God's name is certainly holy in itself; but we pray in this petition that it may kept holy among us also. *How is this done?*—God's name is kept holy when the Word of God is taught in its truth and purity, and we, as the children of God, also lead holy lives according to it. Help us to do this, dear Father in heaven! But anyone who teaches or lives contrary to God's Word profanes the name of God among us. Protect us from this, Heavenly Father.

III. PRAYER OF THE WEEK:

Heavenly Father, even if I don't keep Your Name holy, as I should, it is holy anyway. You are so holy, that, in the end, Your name cannot be spoiled by me. I can spoil who You are for others, and I can ruin my side of our relationship, but you are still holy, still my Father. Help me remember, therefore, to name You proudly. This I ask through Jesus Christ, my Lord. Amen.
