II. Confess the Fifth Petition to the Lord's Prayer: And forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us. *What does this mean?--We pray in this petition that our Father in heaven would not look upon our sins, nor deny such petitions on account of them; for we are worthy of none of the things for which we pray, neither have we deserved them; but that He would grant them all to us by grace; for we daily sin much, and indeed deserve nothing but punishment. So will we verily, on our part, also heartily forgive and also readily do good to those who sin against us.*

III. PRAYER OF THE WEEK:

Heavenly Father, thank You for giving me the strength to believe You when You say, "You are forgiven." Thank You for giving me the strength to let my past sins die. Thank You for telling me to do this, even though I think I should hold on to a guilty conscience. Thank You for a fresh start every day, every moment.
