The following is offered as a daily discipline for your reading, study, prayer, and praise.

I. Begin with: *In the Name of the Father and of the + Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.*

II. Confess the Sixth Petition to the Lord's Prayer: *And lead us not into temptation.*
What does this mean?--God, indeed, tempts no one; but we pray in this petition that God would guard and keep us, so that the devil, the world, and our flesh may not deceive us, nor seduce us into misbelief, despair, and other great shame and vice; and though we be assailed by them, that still we may finally overcome and gain the victory.

III. PRAYER OF THE WEEK:

Lord, when I am able to resist the devil's temptations, it is evidence that You are giving me the power I asked for. It is evidence that temptation doesn't always lead to a fall into sin. Please keep me from being overwhelmed by the evil one, and if I am, be there to rescue me, as You have promised. This I ask in and through your Name for you are my Jesus Christ, my Lord. Amen.
