II. The Sacrament of the Altar, Part 3: The Power of the Sacrament of the Altar *How can bodily eating and drinking do such great things?* Certainly not just eating and drinking do these things, but the words written here: "Given and shed for you for the forgiveness of sins." These words, along with the bodily eating and drinking, are the main thing in the Sacrament. Whoever believes these words has exactly what they say: "forgiveness of sins."

IV. PRAYER OF THE WEEK: Heavenly Father, Your Son has guaranteed to us the forgiveness of our sins and the deliverance of us from eternal death.
