The following is offered as a daily discipline for your reading, study, prayer, and praise.

- I. Begin with: In the Name of the Father and of the + Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.
- **II.** . Confess the Seventh Commandment: You shall not steal. What does this mean? We should fear and love God so that we do not take our neighbor's money or possessions, or get them in any dishonest way, but help him to improve and protect6 his possessions and income.
- III. PSALM OF THE WEEK: Psalm 25:1-10
- **IV. PRAYER OF THE WEEK:** Lord God, keep my needs simple and my motives pure. Let me be vigilant within, that no "easy money" tempts me to take it. If I gain the "whole world" but lose my self- respect and incur Your anger, I have become a poor loser. Help me to trust in what the Apostle Paul says of You in Romans 8:32: *He who did not spare his own Son, but gave him up for us all—how will he not also, along with him, graciously give us all things?* Give me the faith to trust that if You were willing to give Jesus to be my Savior, then You will surely give to me all the other things I truly need in life. This I ask through Jesus Christ, my Lord. Amen.

VI. DAILY PRAYERS (Please try to focus your prayers on the theme of each day):

Sunday: Pray for St. Paul's members to experience the joy of Jesus' resurrection and for the faithful preaching and hearing of God's Word.
