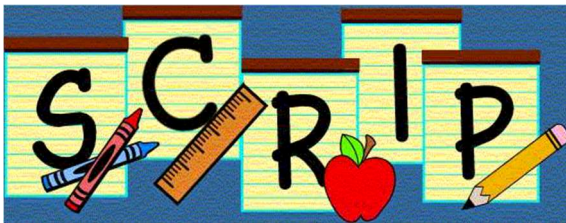
Save the Date

Wear something red and / or green

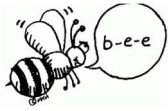
