These days are just supposed to be light hearted and fun. Your child can choose to wear the color or not.






# Christmas Classroom Gift Exchange


A hint especially for the mornings – read the books at home. So you only have to do the testing. There really isn't enough time in the morning to read and do the testing on the book.
