# Save the Date



# Lunch with the Librarian / Principal

We will continue taking tests during the school day; however it will not be enough to reach this goal. Lunch with the Principal / Librarian is for those students who are going above and beyond the school day. Your child will need your assistance in helping them take tests either before or after school. If you plan on taking tests before school, please plan on getting to school around 7:45. Tests can only be taken at school in the library or in the classroom (not at home).

A hint especially for the mornings – read the books at home. So you only have to do the testing. There really isn't enough time in the morning to read and do the testing on the book.


