Mary and Handlers Deploy


On Saturday, June 26, 2021, we were asked along with many other LCC (Lutheran Church Charities) K-9 Comfort Dog teams to consider deploying to Florida after the tragic collapse of the condominium there just three days earlier. By the end of that day, Tom and Dianne Moore had made the commitment to travel to Florida with Mary and by the next Saturday they were on the road to join the eight other teams that also answered the call. They served over one week in Surfside, providing the Mercy, Compassion, Presence and Proclamation of Jesus Christ.

Our entire team wants to thank everyone for their prayers and financial support during this deployment. Your generosity exceeded the travel expenses, especially since LCC covered hotel expenses and many of the meals while in Florida.

The additional money contributed to travel expenses has been given to LCC, asking that they in turn share the donation with Holy Cross Lutheran Church of North Miami. This church and their pastor, Pastor Dennis Bartels, requested the comfort dogs and continued the Hearts of Mercy & Compassion ministry after the LCC teams returned home.

We continue to pray for all the families and friends of those who died in the collapse, as well as the dedicated first responders and search and recovery teams that faced this ominous and difficult task. We also pray for all those families from other nearby condos who were displaced and uncertain of their futures. Each day we listen for God's call to action, and with God's assistance, encouragement and love we respond, "Here am I, send me."

Recently the LCC K-9 Comfort Dog Ministry celebrated 13 years as a ministry. There are over 130 of these highly trained dogs who, along with their teams, share the "Mercy, Compassion, Presence and Proclamation of Jesus Christ to those who are suffering and in need." Thank you to everyone who helped deliver Meals on Wheels in 2020 and 2021. We help provide a much needed service in the community when we join with others in delivering meals. St. Paul's has been participating in the Meals on Wheels program for many years. In 2020 we donated 1,040 hours.

Mercy Health reports, "Together, our 20 plus participating organizations performed 2,646 volunteer days of service (98% ON TIME) which delivered over 21,000 meals to about 100 residents of the Janesville area in 2020. This was accomplished even though we had to cancel the program for two days in January because of extremely cold weather and snow! We also had the stress and working conditions brought on by the Covid-19 Pandemic.
