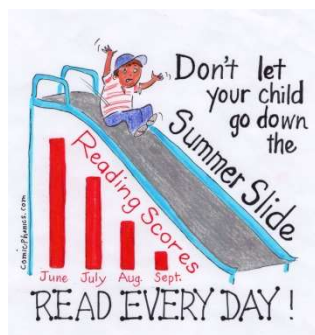


If your child has a summer birthday, and would like to celebrate before the end of the school year, please let me know when you would like to do it. Therefore, I
